We are requesting that the following course(s) – both the grade(s) and the credit(s) – not show on the student’s transcripts. We understand that this means that the course grade(s) will not appear as part of the student’s record and high school grade point average. We also understand that if the student passes the Standards of Learning (SOL) test associated with any of these courses and thus have a verified credit needed for graduation, that the verified credit will no longer exist. (This means for example, that if the student passes World Geography and passes the SOL test, the student would have one verified credit towards graduation. By deleting this course, the student will need for more social studies courses in order to earn an advanced studies diploma – three for a standard diploma – and will need to pass at least two SOL test in social studies in high school).
